



Because commercial Semaglutide and Tirzepatide are currently on the FDA shortage list, compounding pharmacies have the legal right to provide compounded Semaglutide and Tirzepatide, which can make a significant difference in patient care.

Compounded Semaglutide and Tirzepatide are administered subcutaneously (under the skin) in your stomach, thigh, or upper arm. Use a different body area each time you give yourself a shot.

Injections are done once weekly, on the same day of each week, at any time of day with or without meals.

Semaglutide is also available in a sublingual (under the tongue) oil-based liquid that is used daily.

Available Strengths

- Semaglutide/Cyanocobalamin 2.5mg-0.5mg/mL
- Semaglutide/Cyanocobalamin 5mg-0.5mg/mL
- Tirzepatide/Cyanocobalamin 10mg-0.5mg/mL
- Tirzepatide/Cyanocobalamin 20mg-0.5mg/mL

Sizes: 1ml vials to 6mL vials

How to Get Compounded Semaglutide and Tirzepatide

Compounded Semaglutide and Tirzepatide are available at Hobbs Pharmacy. Patients and providers can follow the instructions below to request a prescription for compounded semaglutide and tirzepatide.

Instructions for Patients

If you have a prescription for a weight loss product that you are unable to obtain, please reach out to your provider and inform them that Hobbs Pharmacy is compounding several weight loss products including semaglutide/cyanocobalamin and tirzepatide/cyanocobalamin.

Common Questions for Patients

1. Must my doctor write for the compound? Yes, your doctor must write for the compound. It can't be written for brand names in order for us to compound it. Your doctor can fax in our premade prescription pad, call in the prescription, escript (but must note compound with B12 for us to fill) or email.

2. What is the cost? - It varies based on drug and dosage. Hobbs Pharmacy will call you before they start working on the prescription to discuss costs, how long the prescription will last and expectations on when it will be ready.

3. Turnaround time/Process - Once we get the prescription, we will call each patient. During this call we will discuss costs, how long the prescription will last and expectations on when it will be ready. This medication does require prepayment. Once paid, it is usually 3-5 day turnaround time from when we speak with the patient to the patient can pick it up or have it mailed.

4. Can they mail to me? You can pick it up at Hobbs Pharmacy in Merritt Island. We are open Monday-Friday 9am-7pm and Saturday 9am-5pm. Mailing must be done overnight due to stability of temperature requirements. Mailing is \$55 overnight fee can only mail Monday-Wednesday and within the state of Florida only.

5. Why do you add cyanocobalamin (Vitamin B12)? There are a couple of reasons.
 - a. Vitamin B12 is a clear pink color, this actually helps with visualizing the liquid in the vial and the syringe since many patients have never drawn up a syringe from a vial.
 - b. Fatigue is a known side effect of semaglutide and tirzepatide injections, so adding B12 can help with fatigue.
 - c. Due to eating less, often see patient B12 levels decrease. So the small amount added weekly can help with this also.
